Regulations 2010 (as amended)

Cherwell District Council intends to submit a Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Draft Charging Schedule for public examination, under Section 212 of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended by Section 114 of the Localism Act 2011).

The Draft CIL Charging Schedule must undergo a public Examination by an independent person, before the council can formally approve it. In accordance with Regulation 21 of the CIL Regulations 2010 (as amended), anyone who has submitted a response to the consultation has a right to request

to be heard by the examiner. Such a request must be made in writing before the end of this consultation on 23 August 2024.

Representations may be accompanied by a request to be notified at a specified address of any of the following:

- that the draft charging schedule has been submitted to the Examiner in accordance with section 212 of PA 2008;
- the publication of the recommendations of the Examiner and the reasons for those recommendations; and
- the approval of the charging schedule by the charging authority.

Any person who has made representations about the Draft Charging Schedule may withdraw those representations at any time by giving notice in writing to the Council either by e-mail or by post at the addresses given above.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ANONYMOUS OR CONFIDENTIAL COMMENTS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. ANY COMMENTS RECEIVED WILL BE MADE PUBLICLY AVAILABLE.

The information you provide will be stored on a Cherwell District Council database and used solely in connection with the preparation of the Cherwell draft CIL Charging Schedule.

Representations will be available to view on the Council's website, but address, signature and contact details will not be included. However, as copies of representations must be made available for public inspection, they cannot be treated as confidential. Data will be processed and held in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018.
